Turn left on 414 and stay on this road for 8.5 miles. 414 will change from blacktop to gravel, and once it changes to gravel you will have 1.6 more miles to go to reach the gate. ### SOUND TESTING

All machines must meet 101 decibels or less. Testing will be open Saturday at 9:30am. If you don't pass sound and you've burned your free pass you will not receive points for the series.

### TRANSPONDERS

If this is your first race of 2008, you must bring your scoring tag to sign up so that your new race number can be programmed in.

### ATTENTION:

This park also offers showers in the clubhouse. There is water at the RV sites however it is being requested that these not be used for washing ATV's during the weekend. Thanks.



**ATTENTION:** The schedules have changed so that the final race on Sunday will finish a little earlier. This should allow you to get home at a more reasonable hour. The race lengths are no longer time plus one lap. The checkered flag will now be displayed once the race time has expired. For the "C" and "B" Programs the race time will be 60 minutes. For the PeeWee Program it's 30 minutes and for the "A" Program it's 90 minutes. The white flag will be displayed when there is only 15 minutes left to race. To add a little fun to the race weekend we have added three unlimited classes that will race on Saturday after the "C" Program race. Anyone can enter this race. It would be a hoot to see a bunch of "A" rider's racing stock 250's, or utility machines. When the days get longer we will also offer a buddy race after the unlimited races. Please note that practice on the main track is limited to Saturday morning or Sunday morning unless you choose to line up in one of the unlimited classes. The 3 classes are Open Unclassified, Stock Unclassified, and Utility Unclassified. These classes are for no points and riders do not have to purchase a scoring tag or a membership. A first place plaque will be awarded for each of the classes. If you are 18 years old or older you don't have to wear a helmet when riding an ATV or Dirt Bike as long as you are not on the racetrack. Everyone under 18 must wear a D.O.T. / Snell approved helmet when riding an ATV or Dirt Bike at all times (hard hats and bicycle helmets are not acceptable). An Advisory Committee has been formed to help your voices to be heard. You can talk to any of these folks about ATVCCS concerns, **Phil Enis, Larry Gustine, Glenn Hess, Jeff Porter, Sarah Sellers, and Gayle or David Culpepper**. We decided to move the B Program to Sunday morning so these riders would not have to ride such a beat up track. When you consider the talent level and the equipment they're riding it just seemed to make good sense to move them to the morning race.
